

The CMA has historically held its Annual General Meeting (AGM) and General Council (which has electoral and policy functions) in various jurisdictions across Canada to coincide with the presidential rotation. CMA held its inaugural Health Summit in 2018. In 2019, the Board of Directors approved, going forward, that the CMA would hold the AGMs and General Council components adjacent to the Health Summit in Canada's larger urban centres to facilitate attendance for these events. A 19-year presidential rotation cycle based on membership distribution per jurisdiction was approved by the Board in 2009 and is listed below.
