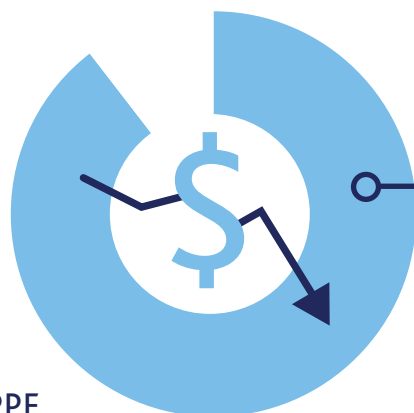


CMA Rapid Poll on the Supply of Personal Protective Equipment and the Resurgence of COVID-19



Over half of physicians (**54%**) are still experiencing challenges acquiring PPE

When considering a resurgence of COVID-19: **58%** of physicians are concerned that they will not be able to access appropriate PPE



The demand for PPE is having a financial impact on most (**86%**) physician practices.

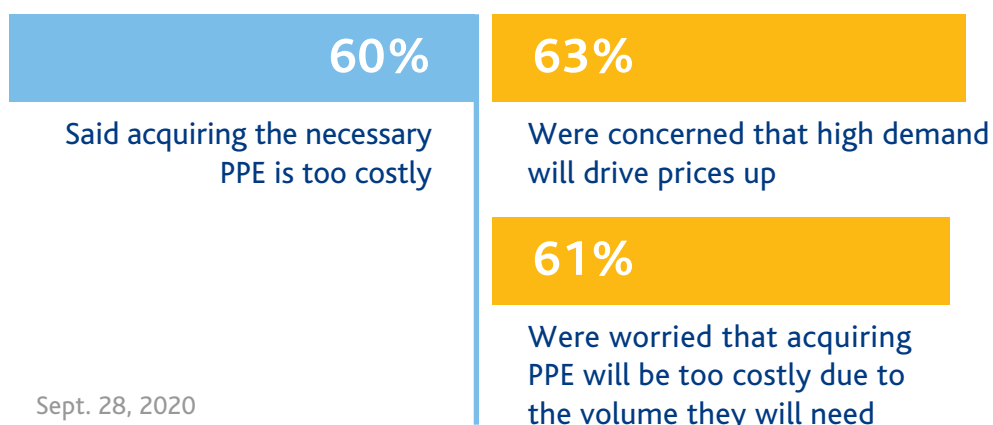

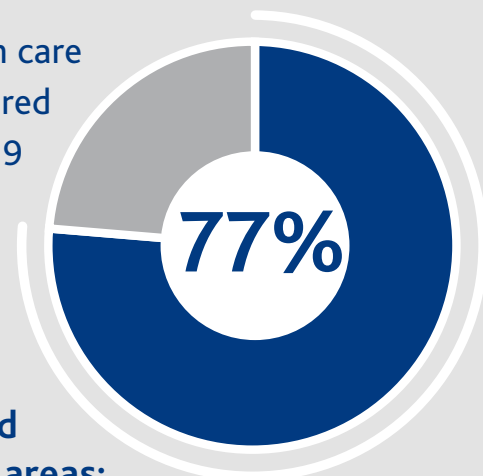
